DOG DAY IN THE PARK

Saturday, June 4 – Riverside Park

Check out this latest information:

- **Change of location within the Park** – Due to flooding, we will be unable to hold the event at the Riverbend Shelter area as we have in the past, so the event will take place at a different area of the park. For this year's event, enter the park at the sign that reads, " Boat Launch # 2, Island Shelter, Disc Golf", which is the entrance across from Guild St. You will come into a parking lot, and there will adjacent designated parking areas nearby. The "Dog Day in the Park" banner will be near the entrance, and the event will be visible from the street.
- **Helpers are needed and greatly appreciated.** We need **at least 12 or more workers** to help with various aspects of the event from set up to clean up.

7:00 a.m. - Set up the rings and snow fencing to mark off the areas for the various attractions that will be taking place. Distribute tables and chairs. Organize the Headquarters area. There is a lot to set up within a short period of time, so many hands are needed.

8:30 – Start taking entries for the Canine Good Citizen Test.

9:30 – Opening Ceremony

9:30 & throughout the day - Hand out participant bags. Collect dog food donations.

Take entries for the 'Fun Contests'.

Assist at various activities, such as the climbing wall and the bounce house.

11:30 Assist Jan Hamming with organizing the Parade of the Breeds and bring your dog to participate, if possible.

2:30 Tear down and clean up the area. Remove all trash. Place the rental chairs and tables in a designated area for pick up.
